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Teaching and studying women writers from Central and South-Eastern Europe using digital materials and tools.



Aims of the CEEPUS programme


Central European Exchange Program for University Studies

- promoting cooperation in the field of higher education between countries in the CEEPUS region
- promoting cooperation between higher education institutions in the CEEPUS region
- promoting the mobility of students at undergraduate and postgraduate level for the purpose of study and research (doctoral candidates) and lecturers for the purpose of teaching
- encouraging the development of joint (doctoral) study programs with an emphasis on the Central European dimension

CEEPUS countries




How does CEEPUS function?




How does CEEPUS function?

- The scholarship / grant is always paid by the host CEEPUS country to "incoming" students and professors
- Exchange students are eligible for tuition fees, enrollment fees and other administrative costs (student cards of the University of Ljubljana are paid by CMEPIUS)
- Applications are made entirely through the CEEPUS website: http://www.ceepus.info/
- Students and lecturers can go on a CEEPUS exchange several times (unlike the Erasmus program)
- CEEPUS does not know grants to cover administrative and / or organizational costs (ie operating grants)!

CEEPUS mobility types

Exchanges for the purpose of study / research / lectures within the network

- 1. Profesor/Teacher:
- 5 9 days and at least 6 hours of lectures
- 10 days or more and at least 12 hours of lectures
- 2. Student: Student: BA and MA during the study cycle 10 months, PhD unlimited
- Short term student 1 or 2 months (min. 21 days)
- Longterm— student 3 months or more (min. Number of days in the last month16)
- Summer, winter, spring, autumn school (min. 6 days)
- Short Term Excursion (min. 3 days)

INCOMING STUDENTS/PROFESSORS grant/dotation CEEPUS

Network and freemover

- ✓ 300 EUR / month (exchange 21 or 16 days last month)
- ✓ Free reservation and accommodation in a dormitory
- ✓ Health insurance (currently valid for AL and Kosovo / Pristina, Moldova, Non EU, ...)
- ✓ The right to purchase student vouchers, subsidized public transport,...

Exchange professors for the purpose of lectures

- > EUR 500.00 net / exchange (5 9 days, at least 6 pedagogical hours of lectures)
- > EUR 800.00 net / exchange (10 days or more, at least 12 hours of teaching hours)

CEEPUS mobility type

FREEMOVER

- > Student (professor only outgoing) on CEEPUS exchange outside the CEEPUS network or between different CEEPUS networks.
- His home higher education institution is NOT a partner in any network.
- Its host higher education institution is NOT a partner in any network.
- > STUDENTS also have the option of FREEMOVER mobility, which is not tied to existing networks, but offers the same exchange benefits as network exchanges.




